ELIGIBILITY AND FEES: This show is open to all members of Pastel Artists of Hawai`i. Entry fee **\$12** per painting for members. Each artist may submit as many entries as you like. Since there is no limit on number of paintings, and there is no juror, the show will be curated by members of the Board available. Ho'omaluhia does not allow paintings to be sold from the show, but there will be a sign noting that for more information, interested persons should call PAH at 808-258-2800. You will be notified of the person's interest/purchase immediately. A 20-percent donation for PAH will be applied to all works sold. FRAMING AND MATTING: Mats and frames should be simple. All mats must be neatly cut, clean and light to mid-value, neutral, muted in color. A colored Inner mat or liner, no wider than ¹/₄" is acceptable. If no mat is used, a spacer should be used to separate the painting from the glass or Plexiglas. The frame itself must not be overly wide or ornate to give an impression similar to a colored mat or detract from the painting.

Frames must be undamaged and wired for hanging. No sawtooth hangers, nails, gallery clips or protruding screw-eye hooks will be accepted. Regular, UV, Image Perfect, Conservation and Museum glass, and Plexiglas are acceptable. Paintings delivered in a chipped, cracked, damaged, or dirty condition, or in an otherwise unprofessional presentation will not be accepted and will be returned at the artist's expense. Caution must be taken to ensure that the submitted paintings are not overly heavy. Neither PAH nor Ho'omaluhia Gardens is responsible for any damage to work hung during the course of the show.

<u>SHIPPED PAINTINGS</u>: All paintings shipped from outer-island members must arrive at the home of Roger Tinius by Wednesday, August 30, 2023, and must be shipped in sturdy, reshippable boxes with paid return

shipment labels or a check made to PAH for the amount of return shipping. Please email show-chair Beth King-Mock at <u>MakBeth19@yahoo.com</u> with information regarding carrier, tracking number, number of boxes, box dimensions and estimated date of arrival (photo receipt with all this information is the easiest). If you're shipping your paintings, please either pay with PayPal by August 25th, or if you plan to send a check, please do so in time for it to arrive by August 25th as well. Paperwork (labels and waiver) can be emailed to MakBeth19@yahoo.com and Mak will have them printed and ready by hanging day.

SHOW HANGING DAY: Friday, September 1, 2023, 10am-noon at Ho'omaluhia Botanical Gardens, 45-680 Luluku Rd. Kāne'ohe, 96744. Bring your paintings with ID TAGS attached and ready to hang **by** 10am. Securely attach each tag to the lower left corner of the painting (as seen from the back). Note, there is a line for "Technique" (to help educate the public about pastel painting) instead of price. Please do include the price on the Entry Form and Liability Waiver so we can tell the interested patrons the cost. It won't show in the catalogues. Please email it to the showchair (MakBeth19@yahoo.com) by Wednesday, August 30, 2023 so we can have the labels ready to attach to the wall as we hang your paintings.

LIABILITY: All possible care will be taken in handling and displaying each entry. However, neither Pastel Artists of Hawai`i nor Ho'omaluhia Botanical Gardens, nor any other receiving agent will be responsible for any loss or damage to any work submitted for the exhibition. Each entrant must assume all responsibility for any loss or damage to any of their work, and should carry their own insurance during the show. All entrants are required to sign a liability waiver for their entries. PAH is also not liable for paintings not picked up during the designated times. These paintings will be left until 12pm, or at an alternate location, for pickup by the artist.
